

Larry, Laurie and others have been contributing their time to this event for many years and deserve a big Thanks. Only a few tables went unsold. Auction action pictured below:





Scott Buchholtz submitted these photos of his MicroAces (English) Albatross. It has a 17 3/4 "wingspan, working out to 1/24th scale. Flying weight is 2.1 oz. He is using an Eflite 300mAh 1s battery. It's running a brushless motor and 3 servos. The ailerons on the upper wing as is the full scale plane. The ailerons are actuated by a pull/pull system using high tension thread that runs through straws in the lower wings. The ESC combo is thumbnail size. It's been flown inside the Kettle Moraine high school gym, but he wants to fly outside to get a good trim flight on it. Scott remarked that is an early morning or late evening flier. Impressive detail is a small size model! Nice work Scott!
